N0381 Phrag. Twilight 4N 'Pimlico' (Eric Young x Living Fire) x
Phrag. besseae 4N 'Kathy' AM/AOS

The Twilight inflorescence is amazingly large and sturdy. This cross should produce excellent red flowers on medium length strong inflorescences . Should have a very good flower count.

N0388 Phrag. Sunset Glow 4N 'Twilight' AM/AOS x
(Eric Young 'Jersey' AM/AOS x Memoria Dick Clements 'Jersey' FCC/AOS
Phrag. besseae 4N 'Kathy' AM/AOS

As in the past, we have 'back crossed' besseae with excellent results. If you recall, Phrag. Memoria Dick Clements and Phrag. Eric Young are both half besseae therefore Sunset Glow is half besseae, as well. We expect better form, especially flowers which show the show the flatness of Phrag. besseae.

To mention a few of our back crosses with Phrag. besseae, Phrag. Don Wimber (Eric Young x besseae) produced Phrag. Rachel Kirk, my favorite Phrag. Up to this time four of these have received AOS awards. And Phrag. Saint Ouen (Hanne Popow x besseae) makes Phrag. Prissy, an excellent red with better form than its pod parent.

(Eric Young x Living Fire)
Phrag. Memoria Dick Clements 4N 'Katherine' AM/AOS
(sargentianum x besseae)

We expect excellent size and great red flowers.

N0397 Phrag. China Dragon
(Grande 4N 'Crystelle' x besseae 4N 'Kathy' AM/AOS)

The pod parent is the largest Phrag. Grande that we have seen, larger than any listed in the AQ. All of you know how highly we regard Phrag. besseae 'Kathy' AM/AOS. How can this cross miss being absolutely incredible.
