Phal. Happy King 'Pine Ridge Orchids' HCC/AOS \$50.
(Happy Smile x King Shiang's Rose)
12 cm beautiful round flower with a tie dye harlequin coloration.
Blooms on a long graceful inflorescence.

Phal. Hausermann's Goldcup 'Everlasting' \$50.
Our old mainstay of yellow breeding is still around and doing a great
job of giving brilliant yellow color to dull flowers.

Phal. Krull's Red Hot 'Sheen' or 'Jim' \$35.
(Katie Morris x Florida Heat)
This is one of the parents of Phal. H.P. Norton and Phal. Orchidview Tabasco
so you know it will breed red.

Phal. Orchidview Tabasco 'Chipotle' each \$75.

Phal. Orchidview Tabasco (Krull's Red Hot x Green Sun) is very much like
Phal. H.P. Norton – both are 7 cm flowers and most clones are bright red.
