- Doritis pulcherrima 'Carlos' \$20
This is a very dark standard color Doritis that came from OZ breeding.
- Doritis pulcherrima 'Freed's Blueberry'

- Doritis pulcherrima 'Henry Wallbrunn'
\$20
The late Dr. Henry Wallbrunn used this clone in his breeding program and it was used in ours about 20 years ago when we were searching for reds by using Doritis. Parent of Dtps. Jim 'Burgundy Smile' HCC/AOS
- Doritis pulcherrima var. coreula
\$30
- Phal. amabilis \$15
Very nice line of Phal. amabilis.
- Phal. amabilis var. clump forming \$25
Unique form of Phal. amabilis which looks as if it cannot keep from constantly growing basal keikis
- Phal. amboinensis 'Spring Creek' AM/AOS x 'OK Red' \$25
Both parents are from Dr. John Martin's breeding.
- Phal. bellina (442 small and 9989) \$35
Both crosses listed are built on a background of Phal. bellina 'Ponkan' AM/AOS and
Dr. Wallbrunn's clones 'Merrill' and 'Bravo'. Both received AM/AOS awards.

out a few years ago that it was changed to Phal. deliciosa. A miniature yellow beauty with lots and lots of flowers.

- Phal. doweryensis (Tejas' AM/AOS x 'Tejas #2') \$35
A much sought after species.
- Phal. equestris 'Orchidview peloric' \$25
A standard color such as 'Riverbend' AM/AOS but has peloric flowers.
- Phal. equestris 'Pimlico' var alba \$25
Beautiful white flowers with a bit of yellow on the callus/side lobes. Unusually flat for the species.
- Phal. equestris Riverbend 'AM/AOS' \$35.
An old favorite with an 87 point AM/AOS and reported to be a 4N.
- Phal. fasciata 'Richela' \$25.
Still one of the favorites of species collectors. This clone dates 'way back'
- Phal. florensensis (Tejas' AM/AOS x 'Tejas Giant') \$35
- Phal. gibbosa mounted or in pot \$25
One of the very small species with a 'hinged lip'. Little color on the lip
- Phal. gigantea ('Frank Smith' x 'Dale' HCC/AOS) \$35
Two great gigantea parents. Seedlings are still fairly small but have only a few.
- Phal. javanica \$35
When this little flowers opens you will have to look for it under a leaf.. Greenish yellow flowers with brownish purple spots forming stripes.
- Phal. mannii 4N var. alba \$250.
Plant was converted with colchicine by Dr. Henry Wallbrunn. Flowers have 5.0 N.S. with golden yellow sepals and petals overlaid with chartreuse
- Phal. micholitizii 'Alexander' AM/AOS \$100.
Judges described it this way 'lateral sepals white with faint chartreuse blush on Upper half.....texture waxy translucent'. 5.5 cm NS

Phal. pallens 'Tejas' AM/AOS

Flowers yellow/green with lavender spots and bars. When awarded it had 19 flowers on five inflorescences, some branching. 5.2 cm NS

Phal. parishii var. flavum

\$25

We have grown these from seed and flowered the first last spring. They were lovely with yellow lips and many, many flowers on short inflorescences.

Phal. philippinense 'Orchidview' HCC/AOS x 'Katherine'

8.5 cm NS is among the largest shown on Wildcatt summery. Beautiful foliage.

Phal. sumatrana

These were also grown from a seed capsule in our lab. Only one has flowered and, believe me, it was a true winner. Truly believe it will be awardable when it grows up.

Phal. venosa

Our Phal. venosa line originates from 'Red Mahogany' AM/AOS and 'Red Chestnut'

These came in one of the very first shipments of venosa to come to the US and we have carried this line in our breeding program since then. .
